## Who We Are

Piedmont Newnan Hospital is a 167-bed, acute-care, community hospital in Newnan, Georgia. Piedmont Newnan is a cornerstone of wellness as the only acute-care facility in Coweta County. Since joining Piedmont Healthcare in 2007, the hospital generated more than \$1 billion in revenue for the local and state economy in the first five years, while at the same time providing nearly \$44 million in uncompensated care. As a not-for-profit organization, hospital earnings go directly back into maintaining and improving services and facilities, and to educational outreach.

Piedmont Newnan is currently undergoing a \$65 million South Tower Expansion Project (STEP) that broke ground in October 2022. The expansion will add 80,000 square feet and three floors in phase one, with the intent to continue to build additional floors in future phases, and is the most significant investment Piedmont Healthcare has made in Coweta County since building this hospital on Poplar Road nearly 10 years ago.
